311- You are part of the process

Often as we bounce across a pot hole or see a street sign leaning into our path or something else that is not right, we think "why don't they fix it". They, in this case, is often the City of Houston, but it may also be Harris County, TXDOT or another agency.

Those agencies count on each of us to help by pointing out those things that need to be fixed. There is no department with employees on the tax payer's payroll who drive around looking for problems and reporting them. That's our job as citizens.

"Call 311 to report potholes and other non emergency issues that need attention."

You can make a difference in the Old Braeswood and the University Place area by reporting those things to the City of Houston's 311 phone line or send an email to 311@cityofhouston.net. The email is great as there is no waiting. Plus you'll get an acknowledgement and later a response giving you notice that the problem has been resolved or referred. If the issue belongs to another agency then it is forwarded to that agency. The system has improved dramatically since its inception a few years ago, with very short hold times if any.
