Your house has a history by Susan Teich, OBPOA Historian

I'm assuming that most residents of Old Braeswood like living in houses that have a history. How much do you know about the people who lived in your house before you? There are clues everywhere.

I found a clue on my back door. Looking very much as though it was, at one time, the front door, there is an outside knocker with the name "Mengden" underneath. I started asking native Houstonians about the name and learned that, between 1971 and 1982 there was a Texas state legislator from Houston known as "Mad Dog Mengden." He served in the Texas House from 1971-1973 and in the Texas Senate from 1973 until his retirement in 1982. Apparently he got his nickname because he had a reputation for opposing almost any bill (Continued on Page 5)

Get your construction plans approved!

The restrictions applicable to all sections of Old Braeswood require that plans be approved before construction of any improvements, including fences, walls, buildings and other structures, or any other construction or remodeling activity is undertaken that will alter a structure or its outward appearance. Approval is required before the construction activity commences.

The Old Braeswood POA is authorized by its charter and bylaws to review and approve plans for construction on property in Old Braeswood. This review is intended to ensure compliance with the restrictions, and will take into consideration the suitability of the proposed project to the site where it will be built, and its harmony with its surroundings. The review will be conducted by the Architectural Review Committee of


the Association whose chair person and other members are appointed by the President.

There are a number of specific requirements that projects must satisfy, which vary by section and sometimes by lot. The ARC will help you understand which requirements apply to your project and how they may be satisfied. Early plan review will help avoid last minute changes that can be expensive.

Garbage reminders

In accordance with Chapter 39 of the city's code of ordinances, trash may not be set on the curb for collection until 6 p.m. of the day preceding pick up. For Old Braeswood, this means that **no trash should be placed on the curb until after 6 p.m.** Monday. Please remind your yard service not to leave trash on the curb during the week or ask them to haul it away.

Please also remind crews not to blow leaves or other debris into the storm sewers, as this clogs the system and creates the perfect conditions for mosquitoes.

that was introduced. This becomes less surprising knowing that he was a Republican when nearly all Texans were Democrats. I read on one Website that, when Mengden "rose to speak, the rest of the Representatives would start barking and howling."

"Ever heard of Mad Dog Mengden?" is my standard question when mingling at parties. Other bits and drabs of information trickle in. Mad Dog grew up in my house with his brother. When his parents died, his brother took the family ranch and Mad Dog took the house. There is also a colorful story, perhaps apocryphal, that Miss Ima Hogg once confronted Mad Dog in an elevator, and berated him for being a Republican when his parents and grandparents had been Democrats. According to one version, she even gave him a light whack on the leg with her cane.

My house is not mentioned in Stephen Fox's study, *Braeswood: An Architectural History*; so, I went to Stephen himself. He didn't give me any juicy stories about Mad Dog, but he was kind enough to identify the original owner. My house first appears in the 1931-32 edition of the Houston City Directory. The first owner was Dolores Welder Crabb.

Dolores was the daughter of James F. Welder of Victoria, Texas, a cattle rancher and chairman of the board of the Victoria National Bank. Her great-grandfather was James Power, the co-founder of the Power-Hewetson Colony.

Dolores left Old Braeswood for River Oaks after the death of her father, living with the first of her four husbands in a 1935 house built by John Staub at Pine Valley Drive and Troon Road, "a magnificent Spanish colonial style house demolished in the mid-80s after her death."
